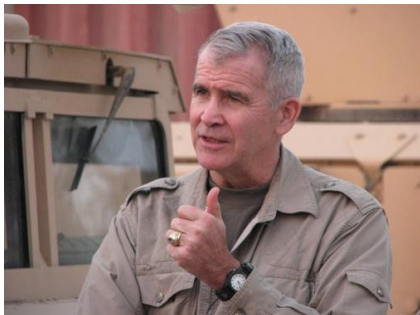

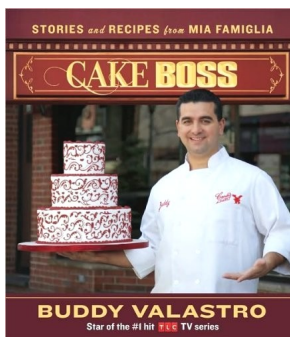

Incognito: The Secret Lives of Brains by David M. Eagleman The premise of this fascinating book is that most of our actions aren't conscious ones: we don't really *think* about what we're doing. He also questions how many of our actions are truly voluntary ones and how many might be caused by physical conditions, such as chemical imbalances. This is one book about the brain that might make you question not only your actions but your very identity. Whether or not you agree with the author's arguments, you'll find this a book worthy of—well, thought!

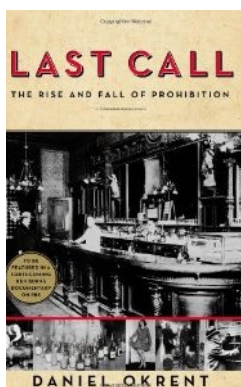

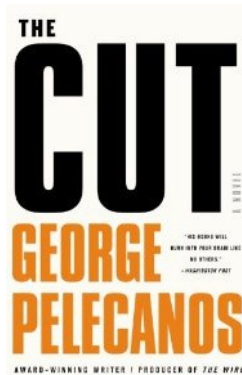

Last Call: The Rise and Fall of Prohibition by Daniel Okrent discusses how alcohol and American history are intertwined in this entertaining, informative and timely book. The book is featured in Ken Burns' new documentary "Prohibition" which premieres on PBS Sunday, October 2. It's a lively and thought-provoking look at the effect the law had on American culture, art, crime, social conventions, and economics.

The Cut by George Pelecanos is the first in a new thriller series by the producer of TV's "The Wire." Iraq veteran Spero Lucas is using his talents to recover stolen property for sometimes shady clients. Lucas doesn't ask questions as long as he gets his cut—forty percent. Reviewers have been comparing Lucas to Lee Child's Reacher; the book is praised by Child, Dennis Lehane, and Stephen King. This is a series to watch!
