

The Bristol Public Library is now hiring a Teen and YA Librarian. The Teen and YA Librarian enriches the lives of teenagers by planning and implementing a program of library services responsive to their needs and interests.

Educational Requirements: Bachelor's degree required.

Required Experience: Experience in planning and implementing library services keyed to the needs of teenagers required. Experience working with teens in a library setting preferred.

Essential Duties:

- Purchases new books for teen collection using book reviews, requests, notable book lists, AR lists, required reading lists, and patron interest and needs.
- Purchases replacement books for missing, billed, and damaged items.
- Purchases ongoing series titles and collections.
- Promotes collection online by way of the library website or social networking sites.
- Maintains collection through a program of weeding.
- Shelves and shelf-reads materials as needed to maintain order and appearance of department.
- Plans, prepares, and conducts teen activities in the library.
- Plans, prepares, and conducts teen activities for outreach programs.
- Plans, prepares, and conducts online activities for teens.
- Attends Conferences and workshops to have knowledge of current Teen and YA trends and issues.
- Stays current with professional literature.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Salary: Starting annual salary for this position is \$30,697.
